






CHALLENGE 4 BEAN BAG FLICK


Each child places a beanbag on their foot and has to kick the bean bag into the scoring zone. Use both feet.





CHALLENGE 5 ROB THE NEST

Place 5 hoops on the ground. 4 hoops on the outside 1 hoop in the middle. In the middle hoop place 5 balls. There will be 4 teams of 2. Each team of 2 go behind each hoop on the outside. One player sits on the ground as a coach and the other has to try and get 3 balls into their hoop before the other team gets 3 in theirs. You are only allowed to get one ball at a time from the middle hoop. When all the balls are gone from the middle hoop then you can start stealing from the other teams' hoops (remember only one at a time). Whoever gets three balls in their hoop is the winner. Then switch to other partner for their go. If you find they are taking a long time to get 3 add in another 1 or 2 balls to the middle hoop.



CHALLENGE 6 DRAGONS DEN

One child is picked as the dragon. He/She goes into one of the boxes. The Dragon must throw the ball over into the other box if one of the children catch the ball they stay where they are. But if they drop it they must Join the Dragon. Only the drago can throw on the dragons side when the catcher catches the ball they can throw the ball back to the other side to try get their team mate back. Last person left in the box is the winner.

COLM THE SCHOLAR

Evidence shows that human occupation in the Carlow county area extends back thousands of years. The most notable and dramatic prehistoric site is the Browneshill Dolmen – a megalithic portal tomb just outside Carlow town. The tomb was built between 4000 and 3000 BC. It is distinguished for the flanking of its burial chamber with two large upright stones (orthostats) supporting the granite capstone (roof) of the chamber.
